Dear Helpers

Thank you for helping out with the Bikeathon on Sunday 19 May 2019. **Please read this letter carefully.** Below is a list of duties and locations, where the P & F Committee has tried to accommodate people's requests, however in the interest of student safety or where fewer volunteers are required, some people may find they have been moved.

Please attend on the day at your designated area to ensure a safe and enjoyable Bikeathon. The wet weather plan is to go ahead with a walkathon rather than riding. Should it be necessary to cancel the Bikeathon due to severe cyclonic conditions an SMS message will be sent to inform parents.

At the Parent Briefing you will be supplied with a safety vest which will need to be returned to the College Hall at the completion of the event. Please **don't bring** in sponsorship money on the day.

The day's programme:

7:15am	Wired Bird Coffee Van available for purchase of drinks
7:30am	Assemble at School. Students walk bikes to the Pavilion.
7:45am	Parent briefing in D04/D05. All course helpers to attend Parents can then travel to their supervision areas on the circuit.
7.45am	All students and parents riding/walking assemble in the Hall for bike preparation and safety talk.
8.15am	Walkers leave under the direction of Mr Sorbello.
8.30am	Groups of riders leave under the direction of Mr Sorbello.
8.45am	BBQ preparation begins in Hall kitchen.
9.00am	BBQ's are fired up.
9.30am	BBQ is available.



What to Bring:

Students: Hat (if walking), sunscreen, helmet, bike, water bottle, enclosed shoes, **House shirt** or shirt with sleeves.

Checkpoints:

Feel free to decorate your checkpoint – the brighter the better!
Please bring: hats, sunscreen, umbrellas, chairs and mobile phones. A shade cover, water coolers, cups and table will be set up for you!
All checkpoints to provide the students with plenty of water.

Checkpoint 1 & 3:

Your duties are to stamp the riders on each circuit and the walkers on their circuit. Stamps will be supplied and need to be returned. **All checkpoints to provide the students with plenty of water.**

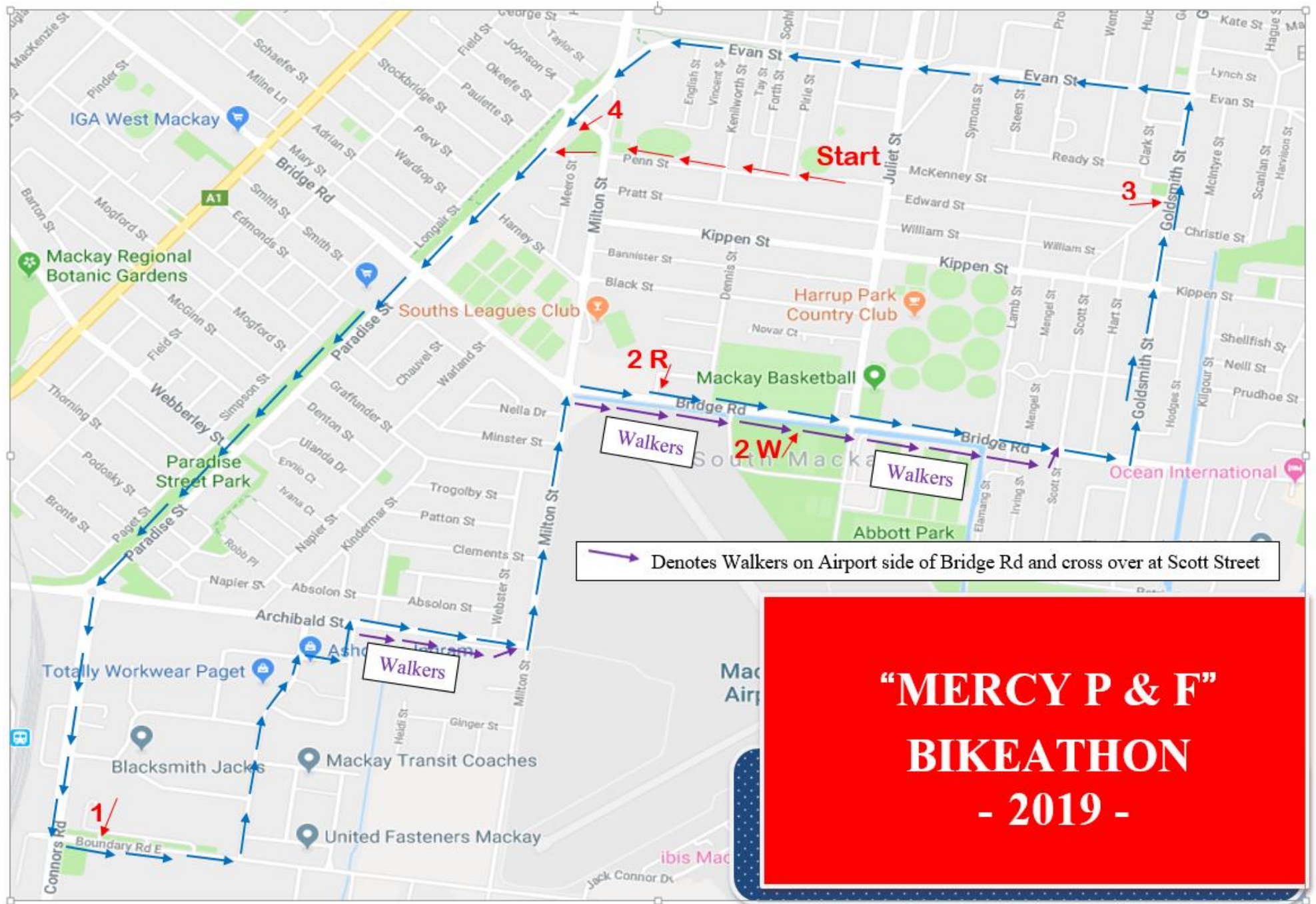
