Parents / Guardians:

The Mercy eSports Club is in full swing this year and is starting to organise their first round of events and competitions.

To assist with organising such events, the students have asked if they would be allowed to bring their own personal console and gaming equipment from home to school. They are responsible for their own equipment and the College is not responsible for any damages to equipment during the events. To that end, the attached Permission Slip will be used as a permanent record allowing your child to bring their equipment to school for use at competitions or school-based events. This will only cover students participating in organised events approved by the College Leadership. Notification and requirements for each of these events will be provided as they occur.

Students are not to bring this equipment to school on days when events have not been organised or approved.

It is a requirement that students who bring this equipment, leave it with the ICT Department for security upon arrival at school in the morning (if an event is hosted during normal school hours). Could you please sign and date the attached Permission Slip and return it to me, allowing your child to bring their own devices for each of the events.

The Club is hosting their second official tournament on Sunday 23 June from 10.00am – 4.00pm in Room N04, the Computer Lab next to the IT Office, under the supervision of Mr Jared Keioskie. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged to cover the cost of prizes for the winning players.

Students will break at 12.00noon for a half hour lunch and are encouraged to bring their own food and drinks as they will not be allowed to leave the premises during the competition.

The game they have requested to play is:

At the end of the day's activities students will not be allowed to leave unless collected by their parent/guardian. If alternative arrangements need to be made for collection, you must notify the school ahead of time. Please drop off and collect your child via the St Mary's visitor's car park; the gate into school will be open and the path to N04 will be available.
